

LICENSE AGREEMENT

AeroSpace and Defence Industries Association of Europe (ASD)
("the Licensor")

and

Non-Profit Partnership "United Aviation Industrialists" (UAI)
("the Licensee")

conclude this License Agreement as follows:

SUBJECT OF AGREEMENT

The subject of this License Agreement is the specification **S3000L** entitled "**International procedure specification for Logistic Support Analysis**". This agreement is restricted to Issue 1.1 of S3000L.

GRANT OF LICENSE

The Licensor grants to the Licensee the license for the use of S3000L (Issue 1.1) after their own translation into Russian language based upon the following terms and conditions:

1. The license is limited to the translation of S3000L into Russian language including the subsequent use and publication by the licensee within Russia and in Russia only.
2. The license is exclusive for translation of S3000L Issue 1.1 into Russian language.
3. The license is granted at no cost.
4. The license is granted without the right for further transfer to any third party.
5. The license shall not be used by the Licensee for commercial purposes.
6. No profit shall be made by the Licensee which may be by, but not limited to, the onward sale of the licensed material, reproduction or further distribution of the licensed material in any form.
7. The Licensee will bear any costs related to the use of the license or its translation. Any efforts requested from the Licensor for tuition, explanation or assistance will be charged by the Licensor accordingly.
8. The Licensee confirms that he will use S3000L only for the purposes it has been published for.
9. A PDF file with the Russian version shall be given free of charge to the S3000L Steering Committee for publishing on the S3000L public web site.

10. The Russian version of the specification shall have the model identification code "S3000LR".
11. The **Copyright and user agreement** of the translated S3000L shall be amended by following subparagraph:

Preferential right of interpretation

In case of any difference occurring between the Russian version of the specification named "S3000LR-UACRU-03000-00" and the equivalent English version of S3000L, the English text prevails as the only valid version as published and supported by the Licensor.

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS AND WARRANTIES

Intellectual property rights on S3000L are with Aerospace and Defence Industries Association of Europe (ASD) as the owner with usability rights for S3000L Issue 1.1.

The Licensor warrants that he has the right to provide this license and the rights granted under the terms of this agreement.

Neither ASD, nor its officers, employees, its members, representatives, or any person who worked on the development of S3000L guarantee, promise, or warrant, that S3000L will meet the needs of the Licensee or any person who may use it, neither any publication that the Licensee develops pursuant to this license.

LIABILITY AND INDEMNIFICATION

ASD does not carry the responsibility towards the Licensee or any other party for the accuracy and the use of the Russian version of S3000L as being translated and published by the Licensee.

The Licensee agrees to protect, hold harmless and indemnify ASD, its officers, employees, members/representatives and those people who worked on the development, publication or dissemination of S3000L from and against any and all lawsuits (civil or criminal), suits, administrative proceedings, claims for damages, costs, expenses, or losses (including, without limitation, reasonable legal fees and disbursements) brought against, incurred by, or paid by any of them, at any time in any way arising out of or relating to the use or application of the license.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

This agreement is deemed to be the entire agreement concluded between the parties. It also supersedes and substitutes all other written or verbal agreements.

No amendment of this agreement shall be valid unless it is drawn in writing and signed by both parties.

The signing parties represent and warrant that they are duly authorized to execute this agreement, and thereby the parties are bound up with all the terms and conditions contained herein.

If any provision of this agreement is held to be invalid or unenforceable, such holding shall not affect the validity and enforceability of any other provision thereof.

Waivers concerning any breach of this agreement made by both parties shall not be considered as a waiver concerning any other subsequent breach.

VALIDITY AND TERMINATION

The license is granted for an indefinite period of time. The license will terminate automatically in case of the Licensee breaching any undertakings set forth by this agreement. All rights of the Licensee as granted by this agreement shall immediately be withdrawn on the day of termination of this license agreement.

There is no obligation for ASD to renew or revise this license agreement.

ARBITRATION AND APPLICABLE LAW

This agreement shall be construed in accordance with Belgian law. Any claim arising under this agreement shall be submitted to arbitration in accordance with the rules of the ICC (International Chamber of Commerce) Court of arbitration, by three arbitrators. The place of arbitration shall be Brussels.

This agreement, consisting of three pages, comes into effect beginning from the date of signature.


